Thursday, October 2nd, 2025

Are you on the City of St. John's 2025 Voters List?

This simple 'how to' guide will assist you in checking the City of St. John's Voters List to confirm that you are on the voters list and will receive a vote by mail kit in mid-September. Residents can also update their information if they have moved or need changes to their personal information.





The 2025 Municipal General Election will be held on Thursday, October 2nd, 2025.

The City of St. John's uses the permanent voters list established and maintained by Elections NL for its municipal election.

To ensure receipt of a vote by mail kit for the upcoming election, residents must be included on the voters list.

You can confirm, revise or request to be added to the 2025 Municipal General Election voters list by using the voter portal on our Elections webpage.

You will either confirm that you are on the current list of eligible voters or that you are not and need to register to vote.

If you **are** on the current voters list you will see the following image, and will receive a vote by mail kit at the address on the screen.

Need to update your information?

If your information as listed needs updating, it is an easy process.

When in this window, select the 'Update' button.





Updating Your Information

When you select the update button, you will see your information as it is currently saved.

You can make your updates, upload ID to confirm the changes you are making and select 'Register'.

Although you will see Register at the top of the form, you are updating your information, so you are properly registered on the voters list.

You will need to upload proper ID to confirm the revisions you are requesting to your voter information. **This is mandatory**.

Providing acceptable identification is mandatory for eligible voters to be added to the voters list through this voter portal.

If acceptable ID is not included, your request will not be processed.

If you wish to continue and register, you need to click the 'Register' button on the righthand side.



Registering in the Portal

Once you select the 'Register' button, the following screen appears.

You will see that your name and date of birth are automatically added to this section.





Complete the form, adding your preferred method of contact – email or phone - and your residential address details.

Don't forget to have your ID ready to upload!

You will now be prompted to upload your identification.

As a tip, take a photo of your driver's license, provincially issued ID or two acceptable pieces of ID that show your name, date of birth and current St. John's address.

You will then upload those images to confirm your identity, age and address.

If you are unsure of what ID is accepted, the hyperlink '**acceptable ID**' will take you to the Election webpage that lists the acceptable forms of ID.



Please note that uploading identification is a mandatory step in the registration process, and your request to be added to the voters list will not be processed without ID.

You must also confirm that the information provided is to the best of your knowledge true and correct, you are a Canadian citizen and have lived or will have lived in St. John's for 30 days immediately preceding September 2, 2025.

Once you have completed this section, select 'Register'.



Step 6 Registration Submitted - Register Another Voter – Finish

Once completed, you will receive confirmation that your request has been submitted and be provided with a confirmation code.

You can also register another voter at this window, or finish and exit.

All requests are processed by Election Staff at City Hall. You will receive email notification when your request has been completed or if more information is required.
