Looking for some Valentine's Day-themed activities to occupy the family this weekend? Here are some suggestions from our Recreation Team.

Cookie Cutter Valentine Snow Painting

Space: Outside

Supplies: Heart Shape Cookie Cutters
Paint Brush
Paint (Washable Watercolors work well)
Snow

Instructions:

Press cookie cutter into the snow to make heart shape molds. Paint the shape using the washable watercolors and paintbrush. It's that simple!

Adaptions:

Want to paint a larger space? Maybe a large heart on a snowbank with a message to your neighbors? A lot of homemade snow paint includes using food coloring, which will stain clothing. To save your snow paints pour some washable paint into a paint tray or mason jar, give the children some paintbrushes' and have them paint away. The possibilities are endless, and the kids get outside and are creative!

Snow Volcanos


Space: Outside in the snow

Supplies: Snow
30 ml of White vinegar
1 tsp. Dish soap
A few drops of food colouring
Small tin tubes or water bottle

Ages: All ages – requires adult supervision

Instructions:

1. Pile snow into the shape of a volcano and secure a small tube or bottle in the center.
2. Fill the tube with a drop of dish soap, lots of baking soda and a couple of drops of colouring.
3. Squirt white vinegar into the tube. As the vinegar and baking soda reacts the volcano will erupt.
4. Lots of fun for the family
